SUBJECT: Announcement to Inform Applicants of the Imminent Withdrawal of the Standard for Overheating Protection for Motors – UL 2111

UL 2111 is a Standard written in "Parts" that applied to three different kinds of products:

- Impedance Protected Motors
Thermal-Device-Protected Motors and
Thermal Motor Protectors

For various reasons, this Standard is in the process of being replaced by three dedicated Standards. Each has its own associated Industry File Review (IFR) that is in process, as follows:

The purpose of this bulletin is to inform all Applicants of affected products that on October 12, 2014, at the conclusion of the last of the IFRs, UL 2111 will be withdrawn.
