INDUSTRY FILE REVIEW - NOTIFICATION LETTER

Subject: Publication of UL60730-1 4th Edition

This Notification Letter announces a forthcoming Industry File Review (IFR) for the Subject Number and Effective Date shown below. New requirements have been developed that may be applicable to your product(s).

Occasionally, Underwriters Laboratories (UL) Standards for Safety are updated to reflect changes in industry practices, revisions to model installation codes, innovations in technology, and/or to address recently identified safety issues. UL assists you through the process of keeping your products up-to-date with changes in UL Standards for Safety through the Industry File Review Process, leading to continued use of the UL Mark on your products.

The Industry File Review Process:

To determine the impact of new and/or revised requirements on currently certified products, UL reviews the UL Follow-Up Service Procedures for each product covered by the new and/or revised Standard. This review includes an assessment of whether any additional evaluation is required to determine if your product(s) comply with the new and/or revised requirements.

It was determined, all current products under UL 873 (XAPX(2)(3), SDFY(2)(3)), UL244A (ATNZ(2)(3)) and UL60730-1 3rd Edition (XATJ(2)(3)), that apply to the scope of UL60730-1 4th Edition only, **will be required** to undergo additional evaluation to continue UL Certification beyond the Effective Date. Any product requiring additional evaluation to a UL60730 Part 2 Standard is not affected at this time.

A Cutoff date is established to allow UL sufficient time to complete work for all customers by the Effective Date. UL established this as the latest date to open an investigation to assure completion before the Effective Date. Any necessary product documentation and samples should arrive at UL and/or factory visits be arranged by this date.

What does this mean to me?

Any products you currently have certified under UL 873, UL 244A and UL 60730-1 (3rd Edition) will need to be reevaluated by UL. If your device applies to any of the UL60730 Part 2 Standards, it will need to be submitted to UL at a later date. More information on these types of products will be provided as UL publishes UL60730 Part 2 Standards in the near future. All other products, pertaining to UL 60730-1 requirements only, will need to be submitted and comply with the new requirements of UL 60730-1 4th Edition, by October 19, 2016. Products not complying with the requirements by this date, will automatically be withdrawn from UL Certification.

Intent:

It is the intent of this file review to withdraw UL 873 and UL 244A upon the Effective Date. To do so, all products currently certified under UL 873, UL 244A and UL60730-1 (3rd Edition) will need to undergo an industry file review prior to the effective date. Many of these products are affected by a particular UL60730 Part 2 Standard. As a result, UL will establish individual file reviews for each UL60730 Part 2 Standard as they are published. Upon completion of these file reviews along with the UL60730-1 file review, the legacy Standards (UL 873, UL 244A and UL60730-1 (3rd Edition)) will be withdrawn.

UL is now accepting product submittals in accordance with the 4th Edition of UL60730-1. Although certifications can currently be maintained in accordance with UL873, UL244A and UL60730-1 3rd Edition, we encourage new product submittals be made to the 4th Edition of UL60730-1.

Action Required:

Due to the complexity of transitioning to UL60730-1 and all of its Part 2's, Action is not required from you at this time.

Plan Moving Forward:

UL is proceeding with the publication of UL60730 Part 2 Standards. Each of these publications will have an associated IFR with completion dates set prior to the Part 1 Effective Date. The requirements in UL60730-1 will be applied in conjunction with those in the respective Part 2 Standard during the individual IFRs. UL will announce the IFR for products that are to be evaluated only to UL60730-1 at a future date. At that time, a Status Letter will be sent to all Applicants with remaining products advising of the models that need to be submitted prior to the Cutoff Date for investigation.
