Subject: Cancellation of Industry File Review for UL 1981 2nd Edition, Standard for Central-Station Automation Systems, Par. 7.1.1

UL's letter of July 27, 2012, announced changes in requirements to determine compliance with the new and revised requirements in the Standard for Central-Station Automation Systems, UL 1981, Second Edition, as follows:

Paragraph	General Subject and Comment
Section 7.1.1	Supply line transient requirements for the protection of central station automation equipment hardware.

Subsequent to the publication of the revised requirements, STP 0205 decided to move the requirement from UL 1981 to UL 827, Standard for Central-Station Alarm Services. Section 11.16 was added to the 8th edition of UL 827 in the revisions published on October 29, 2014.

Consequently, UL does not need to conduct an Industry File Review on Central-Station Automation Systems that are certified to previous requirements, and the existing Industry File Review (IFR) associated with the subject requirements by the Action Required/Announcement Letter dated July 27, 2012 with Effective Date of July 9, 2016 for UL 1981 is being cancelled.
