INDUSTRY FILE REVIEW – EFFECTIVE DATE EXTENSION ANNOUNCEMENT

TO: Subscribers to UL's Certification Services under the Household And Similar Electrical Appliances - Safety - Part 2-40: Particular Requirements for Electrical Heat Pumps, Air-Conditioners and Dehumidifiers, UL 60335-2-40

SUBJECT: Industry File Review – Effective Date Extension Announcement

REFERENCE: UL 60335-2-40

This Bulletin is to advise subscribers of an effective date extension announcement for the ongoing Industry File Reviews (IFR) under UL 60335-2-40, Household And Similar Electrical Appliances - Safety - Part 2-40: Particular Requirements for Electrical Heat Pumps, Air-Conditioners and Dehumidifiers, Edition: 2, Issue Date: 2017-09-15.

UL proposed in a bulletin dated February-12-2019 to extend the effective date for Industry File Review (IFR) under the referenced standard to January 1, 2024. During the comment period, UL received no negative responses and in view of this, the effective date is being extended to January 1, 2024. The effective date extension was established to allow manufacturers the necessary time needed for the multiple items stated within the aforementioned bulletin including the transition from UL 1995 (which will be sunset on January 1, 2024) and applicable products be transitioned to the latest edition of UL 60335-2-40.

Revisions to UL Follow-Up Procedures, including deletion of models and specific constructions on the previous Effective Date, resulting from Applicant requests or prior investigation of products by UL will remain in place unless an Applicant specifically requests that UL reverse such revisions. Applicants interested in retaining such models or constructions until the new Effective Date should contact UL's Customer Service Department immediately
